What is BALTO?

BALTO was created in 1995 by the Student Council Leadership Class as a charity week for Edmond North High School. Because the mascot for North is the husky, BALTO was aptly named after a famous husky, Balto. After a diphtheria outbreak in Nome, Alaska, the only way to quickly deliver serum was by sled dog. Mushers and dogs alike battled horrific conditions to deliver the antidote 1,000 miles from Anchorage to Nome. After just six days, Gunner Kaassen drove his heroic dog team into the streets of Nome. In the lead of his team was a husky named Balto, whose furry face soon became known around the world.

BALTO, at North, stands for "Bring A Light To Others" and is our effort to help others in need. North has raised countless dollars for its BALTO recipients. We have raised money for child cancer patients, victims of car accidents, special education students, and the Children's Hospital, etc. These are only a few examples. BALTO Week is a week full of all sorts of exciting student lead activities. All of its events and activities are done strictly for the benefit of BALTO Week.

When BALTO Week was first initiated in 1995, North's goal was set at \$5,000. This money was to be raised in order to help a teacher at the school. Come 2007, we exceeded our goal of \$100,000 and raised over \$145,000!

The BALTO 2008 recipient is the Make-A-Wish Foundation of Oklahoma. The Make-A-Wish Foundation of Oklahoma grants the wishes of children with life-threatening medical conditions to enrich the human experience with hope, strength and joy. Since being founded our chapter has granted more than 1,400 wishes to eligible Oklahoma children. The money donated by BALTO 2008 will directly benefit Edmond's Wish Kids, and the Remaining funds will cover the Wish Kids of Oklahoma County. We have the potential with BALTO 2008 to fulfill the wishes of every Make-A-Wish child in Oklahoma County, and we look forward to achieving that goal!
